



The AIA Tampa Bay 4th Annual Voice of Architecture Survey January 2022

VOA is a survey of Tampa Bay architects conducted by The American Institute of Architects Tampa Bay Chapter in January 2022. There were 95 respondents.

Survey results:

80% of respondents expect demand for architecture services to increase in 2021.

91% expect the development-related economy to be excellent or good. No respondents felt it would be poor or very poor.

The top 3 most active market segments include Healthcare, Multi-Family Residential and Industrial. Least active are expected to be Historic Preservation and Banking/ Financial.

Healthcare, commercial offices and healthcare were the most impacted by COVID – 19

80% of respondents believe that COVID-19 will change how HVAC Systems are designed.

50% strongly agree or agree that their organization will hire more employees in 2022.

85% expect their revenue to grow with 51% expecting it to be by more than 10%. Only 15% believe their revenues will not grow in 2022.

71% strongly agree or agree it is becoming more difficult to recruit and hire skilled workers.

62% will be continuing remote work practices that were used during the initial year of Coronavirus
